

Smith Health Consulting is seeking registered psychologists and candidates requiring supervision in good standing with the college. Hours are flexible, payment is competitive, and the environment is second-to-none.

Current referrals are primarily from Six Nations Mental Health for a broad range of problems and the Worker's Safety and Insurance Board traumatic mental stress team. Additional referrals are from local community health providers (family physicians, chiropractors, physiotherapists) in Hamilton, also for a range of problems, including injuries after auto accidents.

Candidates under supervision should be planning to register in the areas of clinical/ health/ rehabilitation with adults only. The practice is ready to expand into assessment and treatment of couples, children, adolescents, and families, if the right psychologist with current registration in these areas is accepted.

Experience and interest in working with trauma, including cumulative trauma, and intergenerational trauma and/or assessing and treating co-occurring, multiple complex injuries (including emotional psychological injuries, brain injuries, and musculoskeletal injuries) is an asset.

Additional opportunities for mentorship in private practice concerns, health privacy, and assessment of motorsport concussions may be available, for those interested.

The SHC office is in a prime location to serve the greater Hamilton community. We are located on a bus line, close to the Linc and Red Hill Parkway, with easy access by car or city transit, but on the edge of city expansion with easy access from rural areas nearby. We are particularly accessible for those coming from the Binbrook, Caledonia, Ohsweken, Haldimand, and Brant counties, as well as those in the amalgamated greater Hamilton area.

The practice has flexible office space for testing, individual sessions, child and family work, or group sessions/ consultations and lunch/ dinner meetings. We are next to a pharmacy, and family physician office, and a rehab clinic with physio, chiro, massage, and yoga. We have great relationships and foster cross-referrals with all of these practices. Several other family practice clinics and another physiotherapy clinic are in the same block. A large, 24-hour Family Fitness gym and substance abuse clinic are across the street. It is a rich, supportive, and fun environment in which to encourage physical and mental health. Several grocery stores, restaurants, and big block stores are also nearby.

The practice is almost entirely electronic, with an EMR that includes: customizable session notes; uploading of fillable forms; tracking of incoming and outgoing documents; tracking of sessions, appointments, and treatment plans; links with Telus and other payor systems for electronic billing directly from the program. Electronic information is on secure, off-site servers with multiple backups. Staff has remote access to electronic records via secure virtual private network. Administrative staff is second-to-none and on top of all aspects of the practice.
