Position Summary

As a member of the health care team, the Psychologist will provide services for acquired brain injury patients in both a fee for service environment and an outpatient clinic. Responsibilities will involve neuropsychological assessment, diagnosis and treatment. This includes preparation of treatment plans, scripts and reports; provision for expert consultation to other health care professionals regarding diagnosis and treatment strategies; provisions of psychological services to clients with post-concussive syndrome, depression, anxiety, post-traumatic stress, and with cognitive and behavioural issues. The position also involves program development, research and teaching responsibilities.

- 1. Ph.D. in psychology with a strong background in biological psychology and/or neurosciences
- 2. Registered or eligible for registration with the College of Psychologists in Ontario

- 4. Experience in preparing applications to granting agencies (includes scholarships and research grants)
- 5. Knowledge of both battery and process approaches to neuropsychological assessment and interpretation
- 6. Ability to apply principles of behaviour modification
- 7. Ability to supervise staff including behaviour therapists, psychometrists, and rehabilitation therapists
- 8. Eligible for a part-time faculty appointment with the Department of Psychiatry and Behavioural Neurosciences at McMaster University
