Specific responsibilities of the position will include:

- Conducting clinical screenings and psychological assessments;
- Providing psychological treatment in a manner consistent with standards of professional practice;
- Participating in the supervision of all assessment and therapy cases on a regular basis;
- Examining and assessing client behaviour to diagnose disorders;
- Identifying, on an immediate basis, any problematic situations which may require more urgent attention;
- Applying psychological theory and principles regarding behaviour and mental processes;
- Reviewing literature;
- Completing required written documentation in an appropriate and timely manner;
- Providing required patient contact information for record keeping and billing purposes on the day of the service delivery;
- Participating in continuing education and skill development, including participation in weekly clinician group meetings; and
- Following our company's billing policies.

In order to fulfill the requirements of the position, the following skills and experience are required:

- Earned a doctoral degree in Psychology;
- Registered (or eligible) with the College of Psychologists of Ontario;
- Competent in clinical counseling and/or rehabilitation;
- Proficient in diagnostic formulation, treatment planning and report writing; and
- Expert in the provision of evidence-based treatment modalities.
