The Military Personnel Training Group (MPGTG) provides the Canadian Armed Forces (CAF) and other government departments (OGD) with practical Conduct After Capture (CAC) training. These exercises utilize Stress Inoculation Training (SIT) to create a physically and psychologically challenging training environment. This is accomplished with CAC instructors (CACIs) trained specifically for performing as role players to simulate stressful situations for candidates.

Selection of CACI candidates is completed via an assessment centre (AC) as part of a selection process for specializing as a CACI. During this AC, aspiring CACIs require assessment of their psychological fitness for employment, leveraging the MMPI and NEO PI-3. This assessment is to be provided by a Clinical Psychologist (C. Psych) or Clinical Psychologist Associate (C. Psych Assoc).
