TOH has an opening for a permanent, full-time Clinical Psychologist with the Ontario Workers Network.

The incumbent will work with the interprofessional team in providing services to adults in the Ontario Worker's Network. Clinical responsibilities include providing psychodiagnostic assessments and treatment of outpatients with pain conditions and co-morbid medical and psychological conditions. Prior experience working with WISB patients is an asset. Experience in clinical program development and program evaluation is also preferred.

Applicants will have graduated from a CPA or APA accredited Clinical Psychology Program, have completed a CPA or APA accredited internship. Candidates must be Registered, or eligible for registration with the College of Psychologist of Ontario in adult Clinical Psychology.

Candidates require superior interpersonal, written, verbal and presentation skills, and a demonstrated ability to work cooperatively in an interprofessional setting. An interest in teaching and training is required. Proficiency in speaking and comprehending both English and French is preferred.
