A Typical Week:

- Consists of 18-20 hours of direct client care, 37.5-hour work week
- Weekly case consultation with the mental health team (half day a week)
- Completion of 1 psychodiagnostic assessment (1.5 days a week)
- 3-4 book appointments per day with patients who have been referred for long term treatment (3 days a week)
- Clinic Hours: 7:30am to 4pm, Monday to Friday
- Population: Active Canadian Armed Forces members

Your Key Duties:

- Providing psycho-diagnostic assessments with an adult population including differential diagnosis
- Providing professional services related to the diagnosis, assessment, evaluation, treatment and prevent of psychological, emotional psycho-physiological, and behaviour disorders with an adult population
- Administering appropriate diagnostic tests for psychometric assessment, interpreting the results, and preparing psychological evaluations
- Reporting results and interpretations of tests, interviews, and evaluations to the multi-disciplinary team
- Providing treatment of a variety of mental health conditions for Canadian Armed Forces members using evidence-based practice including the use of Cognitive Behavioural Therapy and trauma processing therapies along with other modalities of therapy
- Participating as a member of the multi-disciplinary mental health team in case reviews
- Leading and participating in the development, instruction, and counselling during sessions for specific mental illness such as anxiety, PTSD, depression and stress management
