Position Description:

The CCR Program at the Centre for Addiction and Mental Health (CAMH) in Toronto, Canada, is seeking one-year temporary full-time Post-Doctoral Fellow with remuneration.

Under the supervision of a clinical neuropsychologist, the successful candidate will provide assessment and clinical consultation for inpatients and outpatients living with severe mental illness, acquired brain injury, dementia and developmental disability. The focus will be on assessments addressing questions of adaptive functioning, broader cognitive functioning, assistance in care planning related to these and other issues. Reporting to the Manager of the CCR Schizophrenia Specialty Clinics, the successful candidate will play a crucial role in providing recommendations for care plans of these populations.

This fellowship aims to refine the clinical skills of the scientist practitioner in the area of neuropsychology, being achieved through didactic experiences and the supervision of clinical cases by the neuropsychologist. Supervision will consist of 4 hours of individual sessions per month along with group supervision of cases. The role also includes training and supervision of trainees and consultations with other disciplines engaged in the service. You will support a workplace that embraces diversity, encourages teamwork and complies with all applicable standards and regulatory requirements.

You will be asked to:

- Complete brief and full psychological or neuropsychological batteries
- Assess eligibility for specialty services (e.g. developmental services) and support application and appeals where appropriate
 - Provide assessments from a culturally competent and sensitive framework
- Contribute to clinical formulations and prepare concise reports for clinical teams and community stakeholders
- Consult on treatment/disposition planning
- Provide clinical training/ supervision and support/consultation services to families, clinicians, and direct care professionals
- Opportunities to contribute to research and educational initiatives

Qualifications:

The successful candidate will have completed aaa PhD or PsyD APA/CPA accredited program in clinical psychology, clinical neuropsychology or related field.

- Eligible or a registered psychologist in good standing with the College of Psychologists of Ontario (CPO)
- Excellent interpersonal and communication (oral/written) skills, along with the ability to collaborate effectively with team members
- Ability to work effectively in a variety of settings with individuals from diverse backgrounds
- Experience in working in a multidisciplinary environment
