



PSYCHOLOGIST/PSYCHOLOGICAL CONSULTANT

The Upper Grand District School Board's 4,000 plus dedicated teaching and support staff provide student success to over 35,000 students who attend our 65 elementary schools and 11 secondary schools in the City of Guelph, County of Wellington and County of Dufferin. The UGDSB covers the ancestral and traditional territories of the Mississaugas of the Credit, the Six Nations of the Grand River, and Saugeen Ojibway Nation Territories.

The Board invites qualified applicants for two temporary, part-time (0.5FTE – 17.5 hours per week) positions. Interested individuals can also apply for both part-time positions for a 1.0FTE temporary position (35 hours per week). This is a 10-month position (September – June) and will start as soon as possible until June 30, 2021 with the possibility of extension.

LOCATION(S): Serving the UGDSB remote schools as well as school locations throughout the UGDSB

SALARY/VACATION:

Standard Grid: \$67,477 to \$86,309 per annum (based on a full-time 35-hour per week position)

Qualified Ph.D. Grid: \$70,983 to \$89,899 per annum (based on a full-time 35-hour per week position)

RESPONSIBILITIES:

Reporting to the Supervisor, Psychology and Social Work, this position assumes responsibility for providing comprehensive psychological assessments for elementary and secondary students, urgent need response, crisis response, violence threat response to schools, behavioural and mental health consultation, programming, community liaison and school team participation. This position will support the UGDSB remote schools. The role will include many virtual tasks including consultations with schools, community partners and families and remote mental health support for students. It also includes in person psychological assessments. Additional duties as assigned.

The successful applicant will work collaboratively with children, youth, the school team, families, special education support services and community agencies.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- A thorough knowledge and experience of assessment, diagnosis and intervention planning for learning disabilities, developmental disorders, behavioural problems, and relevant children's mental health issues is vital
- Registered Psychologist or Psychological Associate with the College of Psychologists of Ontario in clinical/educational psychology will be given preference, although candidates who are able and qualified to work under supervised practice will be considered
- Experience working with children and youth to provide virtual mental health support is an asset
- Experience working for a school board or in children's mental health is a definite asset
