Our focus is on providing interventions that integrate across well-validated methods of psychotherapy models (e.g. EFT, CBT, DBT, mindfulness, contemporary psychodynamic).

At the Toronto Psychology Clinic you will have the opportunity to engage in both individual and peer supervision and consultation. The clinic also runs seminars with invited speakers in a range of areas based on the interests of the associates. We encourage and support personal growth and work-life balance for our associates. Our clinic values relationships, autonomy, and advocacy for mental health services. Providing psychological interventions to BIPOC and marginalized people using anti-racist and anti-oppressive frameworks is a major interest of our practice.

Toronto Psychology Clinic is located in the core of downtown Toronto; near major universities, hospitals and the financial district. Our location allows for a diverse range of referrals and opportunities for collaboration with a multidisciplinary group of professionals (GPs, psychiatrists, physiotherapists, etc.). We offer the option for you to work remotely on a temporary or permanent basis.

- Exceptional interpersonal and communication skills

- Fluency in a second language such as Hindi, Urdu, Punjabi, Farsi, Bengali, Mandarin, or Cantonese is an asset
